- Review annual plans/office audits/Episcopal visitation recommendations to assist as needed.
- Create an Advisory Group to incorporate a variety of theological, spiritual, and administrative levels of input in development of mission based educational programs of best practices in the area of mission integration.
- Prepare written reports; attend meetings as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

- MA in Theology, Pastoral Theology, or Moral Theology or related field preferred.
- Five or more years' experience and involvement in parish life and the Diocese within the Roman Catholic Church. Broad experience in pastoral and parish ministries.
- Must be a practicing Roman Catholic in good standing.
- Strong effective focused teaching skills, including the ability to explain complex ideas, policies and procedures.
- Bi-lingual, Bi-literate in English/Spanish proficiency required.
- Excellent customer service skills which result in the dignity and respect of each person served.
- Experience in creating programs for staff modeling and training personnel in best practices for customer service.
- Must have effective written, verbal interactive communication skills, excellent public speaking and presentation skills; planning, analytical, detailed and organizational skills.
- Must have knowledge and understanding of Diocesan Mission and Vision, and be familiar with dispute resolution criteria.
- Must have effective ability to work well with others and strong mediation skills which builds collaboration.
- Must have ability to listen and make good assessments and maintain strict confidentiality
- Must have effective planning, team-building, written and verbal communication skills.
- Must have exceptional interpersonal working skills at all levels.
- Must have ability to develop, design, implement, and facilitate mission based educational programs and tools to assist growth and understanding of the pastoral side within our ministry service.
- Must have ability to respond to be pro-active.
- Must have ability to maintain all Diocese of San Bernardino Safety and Security policies and procedures.
- Current valid driver's license, auto insurance and reliable transportation is required.
- Must be available for evening and weekend work as necessary.
- Proficiency in MS Word, Publisher, Power Point, Excel and other computer programs is required.
- Must have ability to work effectively in a diverse, multi-cultural environment.
