- Collaborate closely with the Hispanic Ministries in the direction and guidelines of their programs, overseeing the implementation of these ministries.
- Oversee and coordinate the Hispanic Celebrations: Spanish baptismal program, scheduling, preparation, and ceremony; Quinceañeras program, scheduling, preparation, and ceremony; Spanish communal marriage celebrations.
- Oversee and coordinate the various ethnic ministries within the community including various parish ethnic celebrations and retreats.

- Coordinate the annual budget for the Hispanic & various ethnic ministries.
- Tribunal Advocate for the Spanish Annulment Process.
- Other duties as assigned.

## **QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES:**

- Must be a practicing Roman Catholic who upholds the teachings and traditions of the Catholic Church.
- Bachelor's degree and 2 years of experience in Hispanic ministry at a parish or diocesan level preferred.
- Must have a vision and understanding of ethnic cultures and unity in diversity and knowledge of Hispanic cultures.
- Must be bilingual/bi-literate in Spanish/English, and expert Spanish/English translation skills.
- Demonstrated communication skills, including public speaking.
- Demonstrated skill in administration of an organization or program.
- Demonstrated skill in budget administration and financial record-keeping and reporting.
- Demonstrated ability for long range planning and a vision for the future of the ministry and programs.
- Demonstrated ability to organize and prioritize, ability to work in a collaborative team effort and to lead and motivate others to action and ability to delegate tasks where appropriate.

## **PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Includes, but not limited to, considerable use of arms and legs, whole body movement, walking, lifting, and stooping, standing, sitting, lifting and carry 20+ lbs., pushing, pulling, kneeling, crouching, crawling, hearing, speaking, seeing, reaching, repetitive forward bending, repetitive arm/hand motions, prolonged gripping of an item, repetitive hand/finger movements, sense of touch/feel, temperature extremes.
