

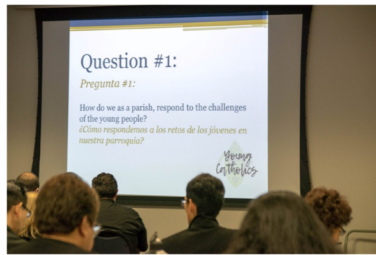
TOWARD THE REGIONAL

Our young missionary disciples continue to carry the torch of leadership by impacting parish leaders with their message of action and hope. Catholic School students from Aquinas High School and Notre Dame High School, as well as youth from the Parish Queen of Angels, Riverside and Our Lady of Guadalupe, San Bernardino, shared their personal testimony that shadowed the Synod on Youth findings at the recent Diocesan Combined Vicariate meetings. The testimony that was unexpected was from a Young Adult whose message resonated the needs not only of the Synod on Youth, but the priorities identified by Young Adults at our Diocesan Encuentro. Gerard Gustillo, a member of the Young Adult ministry ELEVATE at St. Catherine and St. Thomas, Riverside, identified the priority of young people not feeling welcome and often leaving the church. Let us remember the peripheries we went to... The persons we encountered, their sharing and their needs, and open our ears to them and to our families, teams and parish community.

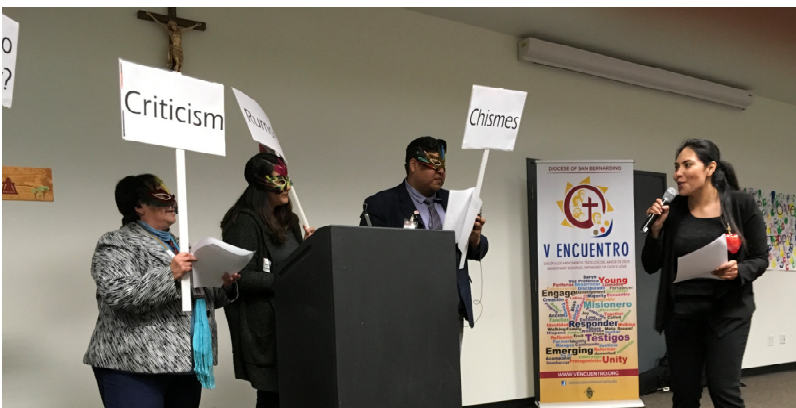

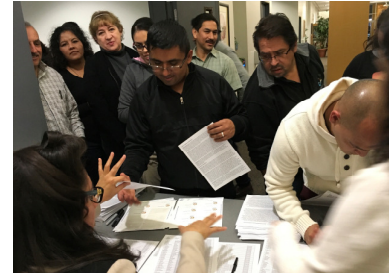

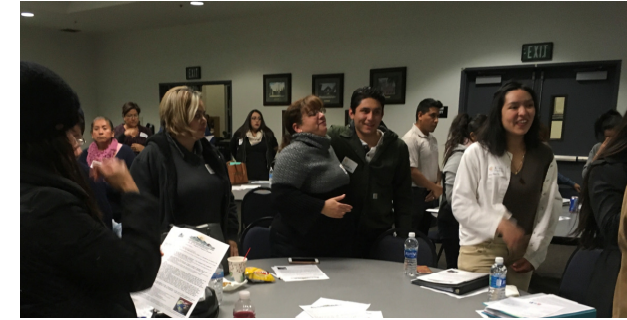
