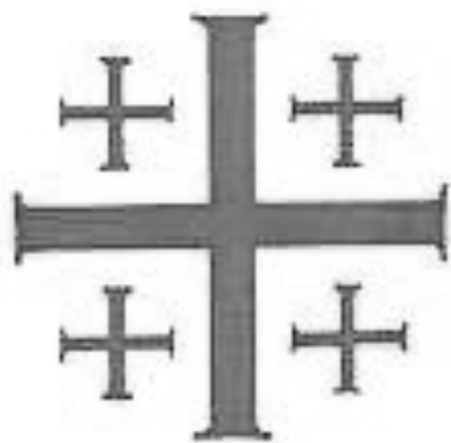

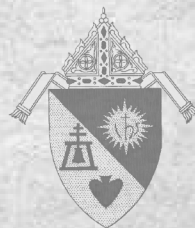

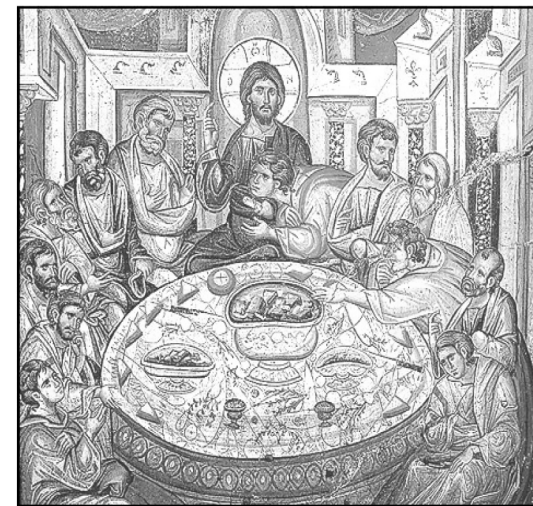

As liturgical ministers we are inspired and we are conscious of the "common priesthood of the faithful". Incorporated into the Church by Baptism, the faithful are appointed by their baptismal character to Christian religious worship.
(cf. LGII)

"Christ the Lord, high priest taken from among men (cf. Heb. 5: 1-5), made the new people "a kingdom of priests to God, his Father" (Apoc. 1:6; eg. 5:9-10). The baptized, by regeneration and the anointing of the Holy Spirit, are consecrated to be a spiritual house and a holy priesthood, that through all the works of Christian men they may offer spiritual sacrifices and proclaim the perfection of him who has called them out of darkness into his marvelous light (cf. 1Pet. 2:4-10). Therefore, all the disciples of Christ, persevering in prayer and praising God (cf. acts 2:42-47), should present themselves as sacrifice, saving, holy and pleasing to God (cf. Rom. 12:1). They should everywhere on earth bear witness to Christ and give an answer to everyone who asks a reason for the hope of an eternal life which is theirs.
(cf. 1Pet. :15, LG 10.)

It is a requirement for certification that CMFP Specialization students attend the following basic ministry classes before or during the program:

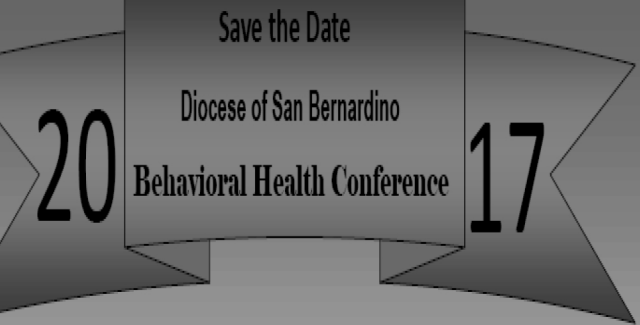

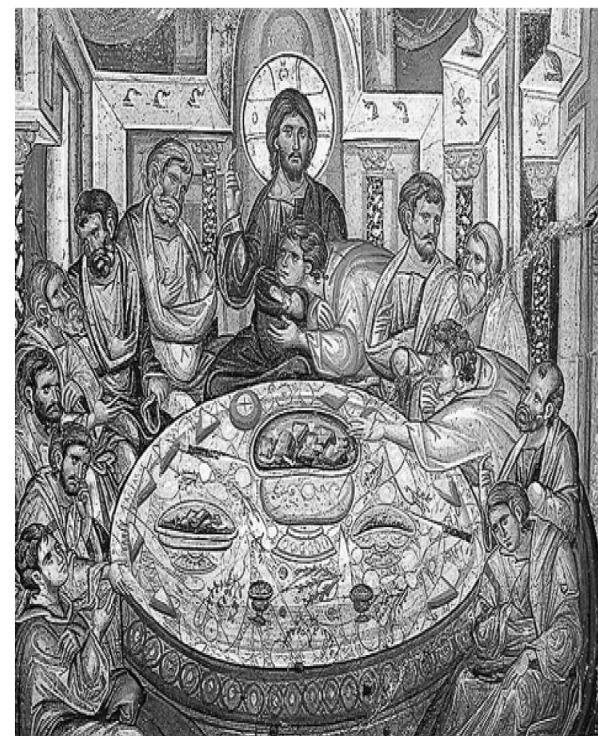

Heb. 5: 1-5), made the new people "a kingdom of priests to God, his Father" (Apoc. 1:6; cf. 5:9-10). The baptized, by regeneration and the anointing of the Holy Spirit, are consecrated to be a spiritual house and a holy priesthood, that through all the works of Christian men they may offer spiritual sacrifices and proclaim the perfection of him who has called them out of darkness into his marvelous light (cf. 1Pet. 2:4-10). Therefore, all the disciples of Christ, persevering in prayer and praising God (cf. acts 2:42-47), should present themselves as sacrifice, saying, holy and pleasing to God (cf. Rom. 12:1). They should everywhere on earth bear **witness** to Christ and give an answer to everyone who asks a reason for the hope of an eternal life which is theirs. (cf. 1Pet. :15, LG 10.)*

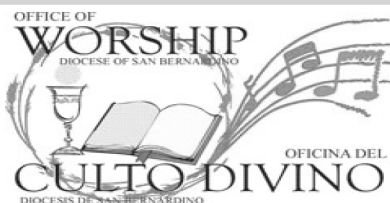
