Holy Innocents Catholic Church Hosts Advent Parish Mission

Holy Innocents Catholic Church in Victorville, California will host an Advent Parish Mission on December 1st through December 4th, 2014. The English parish mission will be presented on Monday, December 1st and Tuesday, December 2nd from 7 - 8:30 pm by Fr. Quinn Mann of the Diocese of Green Bay, Wisconsin. The Spanish parish mission will be presented on Wednesday, December 3rd and Thursday, December 4th from 7 - 8:30 pm by Dr. Jose Antonio Medina of the Diocese of San Bernardino, California.

Fr. Quinn Mann is the Founder and Director of Catholic Youth Expeditions Inc. (CYE) located in Door County, WI. He is also the Associate Vocations Director for the Diocese of Green Bay. Before seminary he graduated from Hillsdale College, majoring in Business Marketing & Political Economy. Fr. Quinn graduated from Mundelein Seminary with a Masters of Divinity (M.Div). He was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Green Bay in 2006 by Bishop David Zubik. Fr. Quinn's interests include: waterskiing, kayaking, hiking, cross-country skiing, and vehicle restoration.

Dr. José Antonio Medina is the director of the Office of Continuing Formation of Priests for the Diocese of San Bernardino, California, where he previously served as an instructor for the Ministry Formation Institute and a consultant to the Office of Catechetical Ministry and Office of Charismatic Renewal. Dr. Medina holds a doctorate in sacred theology from the Pontifical University of Salamanca, Spain, and brings considerable statewide and national experience as a teacher of the Catholic faith to both clergy and lay people. He has served as an adviser to United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, the California Catholic Conference and Liguori Publications.
