Please note that the Diocese, nor Human Resources, nor EOC retain copies of anyone's vaccination cards issued as a result of our vaccination/testing clinics at the parishes.

The law does not permit us to retain this information.

The 'vaccinate or test' mandate from the Biden administration has not been adopted by California, as yet. The State Department of Public Health (CDPH) has stated it will not proceed with CalOSHA adoption of this requirement until such time as the recent Federal Appeals Court decisions, rendered in other States, has been resolved – most probably at the SCOTUS level. This is not anticipated into well into December 2021.

BUT, vaccinated individuals may be required to show proof of vaccination in California for certain employers (NOT the Diocese); entrance to certain large entertainment venues, such as Disneyland, concert venues etc. ; certain retail and commercial establishments such as restaurants, bars etc. AND in certain counties within California not to mention travel on any type of public transit – trains, buses, airlines etc. Thus, it is best to keep this information with you at all times – whether in hard copy or digitally.

If you lose or misplace your vaccination card – OR if a parishioner who was vaccinated at one of our parish clinics loses his/her card – then, they can be retrieved from the State Department of Public Health data base. To retrieve a copy of your COVID vaccination record here in California, enter the following into your Search Engine:

This site will enable you to retrieve your vaccination card, and to sign up for a DIGITAL copy which you can retain on your cellphone. It is anticipated that proof of vaccination for this type of virus will be required at certain establishments at least through 2023. So, retaining it on your cellphone is the best way to ensure you have it when needed. This digital copy will show type of vaccine; dates of inoculation of first dose, second dose and booster.

NO OTHER PERSONAL MEDICAL INFORMATION IS RETAINED ON THIS SITE. It is only information on receipt of the COVID vaccine.
