"God is love. Our Father loves us with the perfection of His love. So much did He love the world that He has sent Christ, so that everyone who listens to His word and believes in Him, may have everlasting life.

With the same love of my Holy Father, I love every one of you. I remain in the love of my Father because I do His will and keep His commandments. By his actions Jesus has entrusted us with the message that we are loved by God and that we are to love one another as God loved us. He has called everyone individually and in spiritual ways, to be converted, then to imitate Christ and to obtain perfection by helping others become more like Christ.
