RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

1. Provides musical accompaniment at assigned weekend liturgy and other sacramental liturgies and liturgical celebrations using choirs.
2. Provides musical accompaniment for choir and choir director for weekly rehearsals for assigned weekend liturgy and other rehearsals related to special or seasonal liturgies.
3. Provides musical accompaniment for choir and choir coordinator prior to the assigned liturgy as required by the music director.
4. Encouraged to further his or her ministry by participating in ministry formation programs and workshops sponsored by the Diocese of San Bernardino and others, as recommended by the supervisor.
5. Attends meetings of all music ministers as called by the Director of Liturgy and Music.
6. Arrives at rehearsals and services in a timely fashion by agreement with the choir coordinator; dresses appropriately and observes other protocols requested.
7. Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES:

1. Must have a minimum of five years' experience and/or training playing piano and/or guitar.
2. Must have the ability to read music and play by sight.
3. Previous experience in accompanying music for worship services is highly desirable. Familiarity with Catholic liturgical procedures and processes a plus.
4. Must be able to play on electronic and/or acoustical piano or guitar.
5. Some organ experience is desirable but not essential.
6. Must have ability to interact professionally with all employees and people coming into the parish.
7. Must have ability to work in a multi-cultural environment.

Physical Requirements:

Sitting, hearing, seeing, repetitive arm and hand motions, repetitive hand/finger movement, repetitive foot/ankle movement, sense of touch, feel. Ability to lift and carry up to 20 lbs. of music and accompaniment books.
