Position Summary:

The Spanish Music Coordinator will lead and support the liturgical music ministry for our Spanish-speaking community while also collaborating with our English-language music team. This role requires a passionate and skilled musician who can lead worship in both **English and Spanish**, with the ability to **sing and accompany (piano preferred)**.

Key Responsibilities:

- Plan and lead music for weekly Spanish Masses and other bilingual liturgical celebrations.
- Recruit, train, and rehearse with volunteer musicians and choir members.
- Collaborate with the Director of Music Ministry and pastoral staff on liturgical planning.
- Provide music for bilingual liturgies, including Holy Days, weddings, funerals, and parish events as needed.
- Maintain a repertoire of culturally appropriate liturgical music in both English and Spanish.

Qualifications:

- **Bilingual in English and Spanish, with strong verbal and written communication skills.**
- Strong vocal and instrumental skills (piano preferred).

- Availability to work weekends, some evenings, and Holy Days.
