RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Designs catechetical programs, which support lifelong learning and conform to the National Catechetical Directory (NDC), diocesan guidelines, parish needs, and contemporary culture while conducting the need assessments in the parish.
- Articulate a vision of catechesis and the catechetical process based on the major catechetical documents of the Church.
- Integrates insights from current catechetical literature into program planning.
- Develops goals, objectives, and strategies for the total religious education program.
- Articulates a vision/direction for the parish catechetical program.
- Pursues further education and professional development.
- Review, evaluate, and develop programs, mission, statements, long-and short-range goals, and objectives.
- Develops a coordinated approach toward parish religious education, i.e., faith development through catechesis on all levels—designs catechetical
 programs that meet the needs of the parish community.
- Recruits/hires, trains, supervises and evaluates catechists and support staff.
- Maintains relationship with pastor, other parish staff members, commission, catechetical staff, and Diocesan Office of Religious Education.
- Develops individualized programs for parishioners with special religious education needs.
- Is responsible for the maintenance of parish library and acquisition and maintenance of AV equipment.
- Shares responsibility with other staff members for building maintenance, improvement, and space design.
- Apply appropriate principles of human development, especially faith and moral development, to a catechetical program.
- Utilize appropriate methodologies of adult-centered, adolescents, and child-centered learning.
- Implement or support a program of catechist formation according to the diocesan certification norms.

QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES:

Any combination of experience and education likely to provide the required knowledge, skills, and abilities, typically:

- Must be a practicing Roman Catholic in full communion with the Church with a commitment to his/her own faith life.
- Requires a minimum of 5 years in a catechetical ministry along with a minimum three years in a supervisory/management capacity.
- Expected to have capabilities in: Theology, Program Development, Education, Communication and Relationship, and Administration and
- Management.
- The ability to successfully complete a criminal history and background check.
- Bilingual/bi-literate ability is highly recommended
- Master's Degree in Theology/ Religious Education, or other related theological field and sixty clock hours of in-service in the following areas (administration, educational methods, supervision or catechetic).
- Master's Degree in Education or Educational Administration with twenty-four-semester credits in Theology and Catechetic.
- Master's in an unrelated field with twenty-four-semester credits in Theology and Catechetic and six credits or sixty clock hours of in-service in the following areas (administration, educational methods, supervision, and catechetic).
- Expected to have a minimum of three years teaching experience in a Catholic school or equivalent and at least one year of paid administrative experience.
- Completion of MFI program and certification as a Master Catechist with a minimum of two years college background in a relevant field.
- Excellent communication skills, verbal and written, and excellent human relations and interpersonal skills.
- Must demonstrate thorough knowledge of Catholic catechetical processes and protocols.

To perform effectively in this position the incumbent is required to have the following skills:

- A working knowledge of, and a strong commitment to the mission of fostering lay leadership in the Catholic Church.
- Well-developed knowledge of Scripture, the Catechism, Church documents.
- Familiar with Church history, the stories of the saints and martyrs, Mariology.
- Experienced in teaching the faith to adults, youth, and children.
- Able to communicate with all age groups, from varying cultural and social backgrounds.
- Skilled organizer and overseer of catechetical programs that incorporate volunteer contributions.
- Sensitive to controversial issues and able to respond according to Church teaching as articulated by the Bishop.
- Excellent ability to work collaboratively with the pastor and parish staff, volunteers, catechists, and parents.
- Must have ability to interact professionally with all employees and people coming into the office.
- Familiar with the use of media technology for effective program implementation.
- Must be able to work both independently and in a team environment.
- Flexible hours and may be necessary to work occasional weekends.
- Must have ability to work in a multi-cultural environment.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Includes but not limited to considerable use of arms and legs, whole-body movement, walking, lifting, and stooping, standing, sitting, lifting and carrying up to 40 lbs., pushing, pulling, kneeling, crouching, crawling, bending, hearing, speaking, seeing, reaching, repetitive forward bending, repetitive arm/hand motions, prolonged gripping of an item, repetitive hand/finger movements, sense of touch/feel, temperature extreme, and sit for sustained periods of time on a daily basis.
