**1st Generation:** Immigrants are the first to leave their country or environment and join another culture.

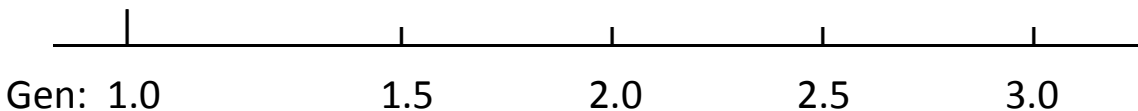
**Generation 1.5:** Children born in Latin America, who migrate with their parents when they are of young age. They still remember their country, their first language was Spanish, but educated in

**2<sup>nd</sup> Generation:** The children of immigrants; born and educated in the United States.

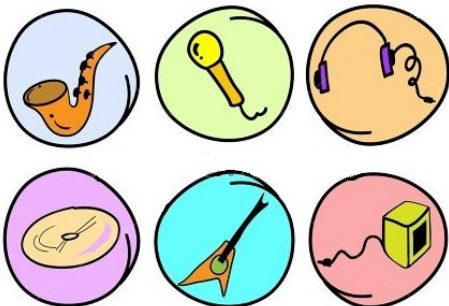
**3<sup>rd</sup> Generation:** Grandchildren of Immigrants, their parents are of Hispanic/Latino descent but were born and grew up in the United States.
